Friday, February 26 2:00pm--2:30pm

Initial gathering will be at the Visitor center at St Marks. Go through the toll gate and the Visitor Center is down on your right. This is a National Park and your National Parks Pass is good here. Anyone coming on Friday can meet here to discuss afternoon shooting.

Friday, February 26 7:30pm

Meet again for dinner at Hamaknockers BBQ, just south of Crawfordville on Route 319 (edge of town). So if you come late on Friday but want to join the group join the group for dinner – just for dinner drop in at Hamaknockers BBQ. Their phone number is 850-926-4737.

Saturday, February 27 Early Morning

Early morning risers are on your own, or are free to make arrangements for early shooting if you care to buddy up. Do this Friday evening on your own. Sunrise is at 7:05am Eastern Time. “Early bird catches the worm”

Saturday, February 27 2pm--2:30pm

Saturday, February 27 5:30pm

Gather at St. Mark’s lighthouse for great photos. Moonrise is at 5:45pm - Sunset is at 6:34pm - Low tide is at 7:23pm. There are many reflecting pools.

Saturday, February 27 7:30 pm

Dinner gathering will be at the OUZTSTOO Oyster Bar, just west of the St Marks exit on highway 98. It’s at the St Marks River Bridge (850-925-6448). **After dinner** we will set up a screen and laptop to show photos if anyone is interested in “chimping” the days work. This will be at the Inn at Wildwood lobby, just drop in and bring your digital cards...

Sunday, February 28 9:45am

Gather at Wakulla Springs for the boat tour. The boat leaves at 10:00 and lasts

45 minutes. You must purchase your ticket before the ride.

Sunday, February 28 11:30 am

Gather for lunch at the Wakulla Springs Lodge, just up from the boat dock.

Sunday, February 28 1 pm

We will go to photograph a field of rusty old cars, located on Rt. 319, north of Rt. 98 on your left about half way to Crawfordville.

Sunday, February 28 Afternoon

The afternoon you are on your own to shoot whatever "Old Florida" has to offer on your trip home, perhaps driving back to Pensacola the scenic route down U.S. Highway 98.
